
Christianity's Misconceptions of Women by Peter Michas (booklet)

This is in sharp contrast to the Biblical perspective.

The Word of God clearly shows the equality of men and women from the moment of their creation, and marriage as a coequal relationship. In Old Testament times, the position and status of women in the Israelite community reflected this Biblical equality and importance, in stark contrast to the subservient role of women in the pagan world. Under the New Covenant mediated by Messiah Yeshua, there is no partiality based upon sex, and women are free to function in all aspects of the Body of Messiah as

they are called by God.

The issues of leadership and teaching, headship and covering, the marital relationship, submission of women, proper dress and adornment are thoroughly discussed from the Biblical perspective. Errors of translation and interpretation, including deliberate alterations in the Word of God itself, that give rise to erroneous concepts and doctrines are examined, corrected, and clarified for an accurate understanding of what the Bible really says.
