In addition, Peter understood that it is essential to understand the history of Christianity, from the first-century church in its original form and how it changed and developed over time, especially under the influence of paganism and Roman-Greek philosophic thought. Long ago, Christianity was robbed of its true Biblical Roots, as pagan holidays, traditions, beliefs, practices, etc. were absorbed from the pagan world.

Peter's Greek heritage provides him with a unique understanding of Mediterranean culture and history, as well as the Greek language. He graduated from Bethesda Bible College in San Diego, California and began a 501(c)3 not-for-profit nondenominational ministry in 1980. Peter has also worked with the Israel Foreign Ministry office to promote a better understanding between Christian and Jewish communities.
